The Commissioner's Court of Shackelford County announces by
Resolution on March 23, 2020:

In response to directives from Texas Governor Greg Abbott, Centers for Disease Control, and the Texas Dept. of State Health Services in order to ensure the health and safety of our employees and our County residents, the Shackelford County Courthouse will remain operational but with limited access to the public until further notice.

County officials are working diligently to stay informed as to the newest information regarding COVID-19 mitigation and control. Although no confirmed cases of the coronavirus have been reported in Shackelford County, we encourage everyone to remain calm and not panic. Take precautionary measures to ensure everyone's health and safety.

Beginning 8:30 am Tuesday March 24, 2020 the Shackelford County Offices will limit access. The doors of the Courthouse will remain locked. Employees will remain working and the County will encourage the public to contact each office by phone. A list of the operational County Offices and Phone Numbers will be posted on the North and East doors of the Courthouse as well as on the County's Website. The JP Office will post a similar sign on their front door, as well.
